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It seems such a long time ago since we last wrote to you with regards to homework and it now seems like the right time to give you an update so that you can support your children at home.

In the past, each child has brought a homework book to and from school; however, as we are trying to reduce the amount of things that are transferred between home and school we are going to continue to use Purple Mash to set homework tasks. This isn't possible with every activity but every little helps! If you do not have access to Purple Mash at home, a paper copy will be sent with your children.

Please find below information with regards to the homework expectations we have shared with your children.

## Year 1 and 2 homework:

### Tasks:

Activity	Where to find the activity	Recommended time spent on the activity
<b>Reading</b> Reading diaries will be checked by a member of school staff regularly.	<i>Reading books and diaries must be brought to school and taken home every day.</i>	15 – 20 minutes daily and recorded in reading diaries. Your child needs to have read the book 3 times (each time recorded in the log) before they can change their book.
<b>Recall of 2x 5x 10x facts (Y2 ONLY)</b>	<i>TTRockstars</i>	5 minutes daily where possible
<b>Maths or English activity</b>	<i>Purple Mash</i>	10 minutes per week
