Year 6	Booster Teacher (1 term – autumn) We have prioritised our Y6 Disadvantaged and lowest 20%+ attainers. For the Autumn term 2020, they received bespoke catch-up daily teaching for Reading, Writing and Maths. This intervention was specifically planned to contribute to catch-up of lost learning and to close the attainment gap between them and their peers.				
Year 5	Booster Teacher (1 term – summer) We have prioritised our Y5 Disadvantaged and lowest 20%+ attainers. For the Summer term 2021, they will receive bespoke catch-up daily teaching for maths and reading. This intervention has been specifically planned to contribute to catch-up of lost learning and to close the attainment gap between them and their peers.				
KS2	Booster Teaching Assistant (3 terms) We have prioritised our KS2 Disadvantaged and lowest 20%+ attainers. KS1	Booster Teacher (3 terms)/ Booster Teaching Assistant (1 term - summer) We have prioritised our KS1 Disadvantaged and lowest 20%+ attainers in Reading. For the academic year 2020-21 where COVID restrictions allowed, they received bespoke catch-up daily teaching for Reading and Phonics. This intervention was specifically planned to contribute to catch-up of lost learning and to close the attainment gap between them and their peers. Throughout the summer term 2021, daily bespoke 1:1 intervention will be delivered for those children identified as the lowest 20%+.				
EYFS	Booster Teaching Assistant (1 term - summer) We have prioritised specific EYFS children who have additional speech and language needs. By implementing the Nuffield Early Language Intervention (NELI), identified children are expected to be better prepared for Y1 and have the necessary oral language and early literacy skills needed.
