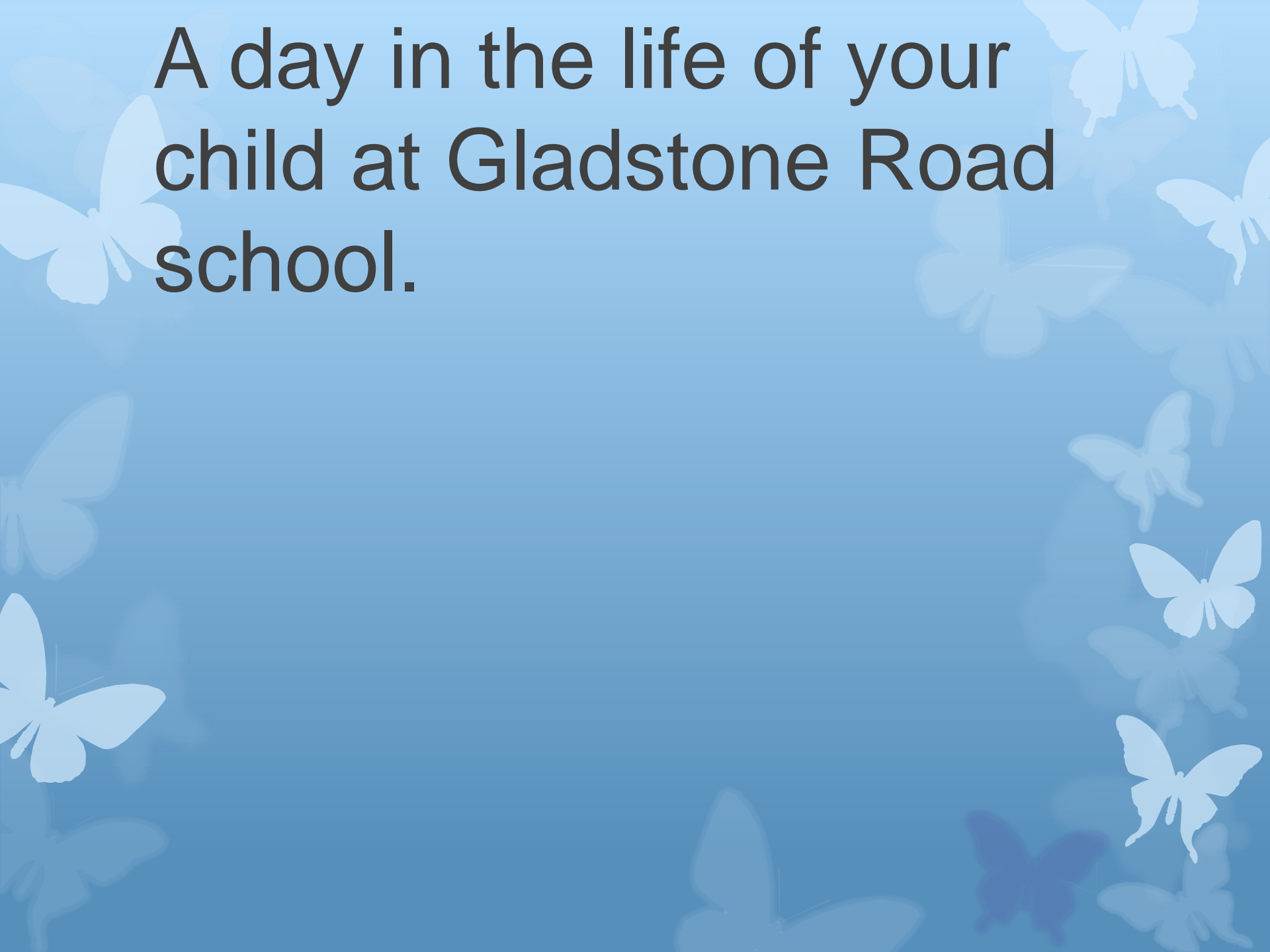

# Literacy group work

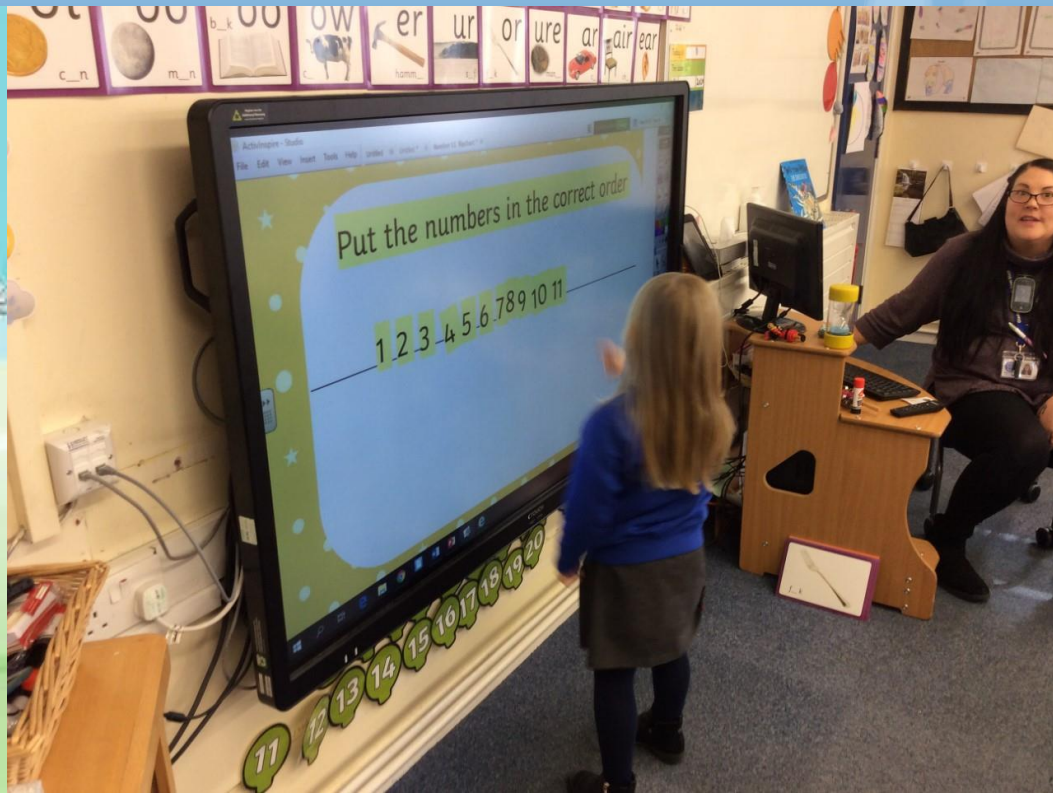
- Guided writing – writing names, lists and stories.

- Children investigating shape.






# Throughout the day.....

# Creative area

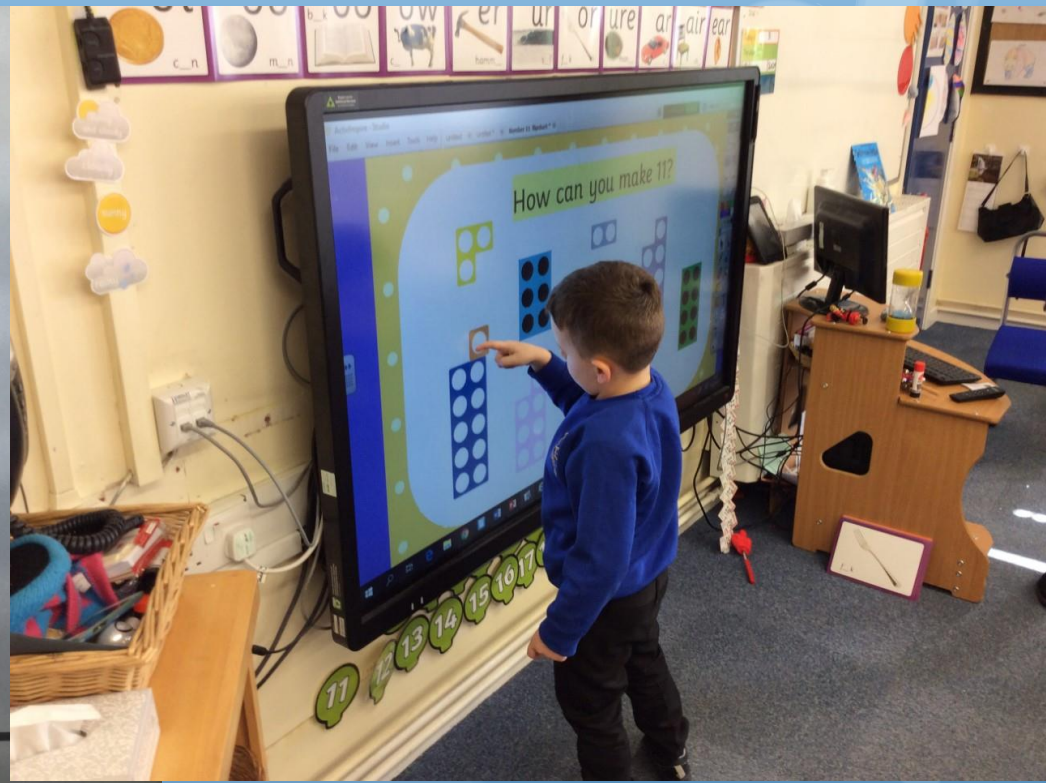
- Here children learn cutting skills, joining materials in different ways, model making.





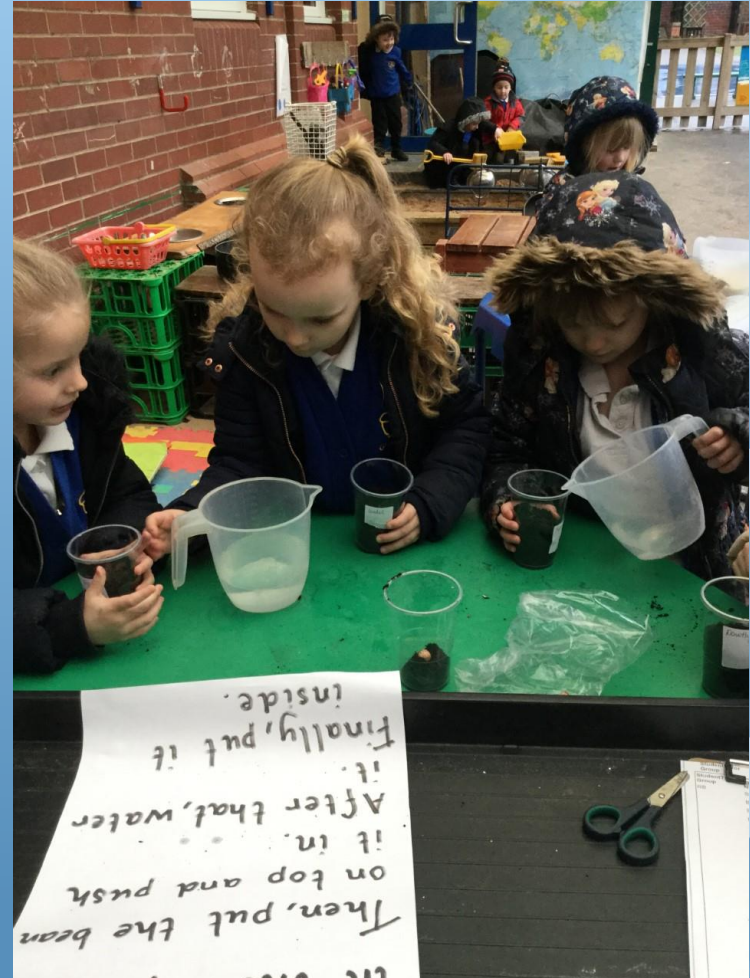
# Smart board

● Create, invent, construct, deconstruct.





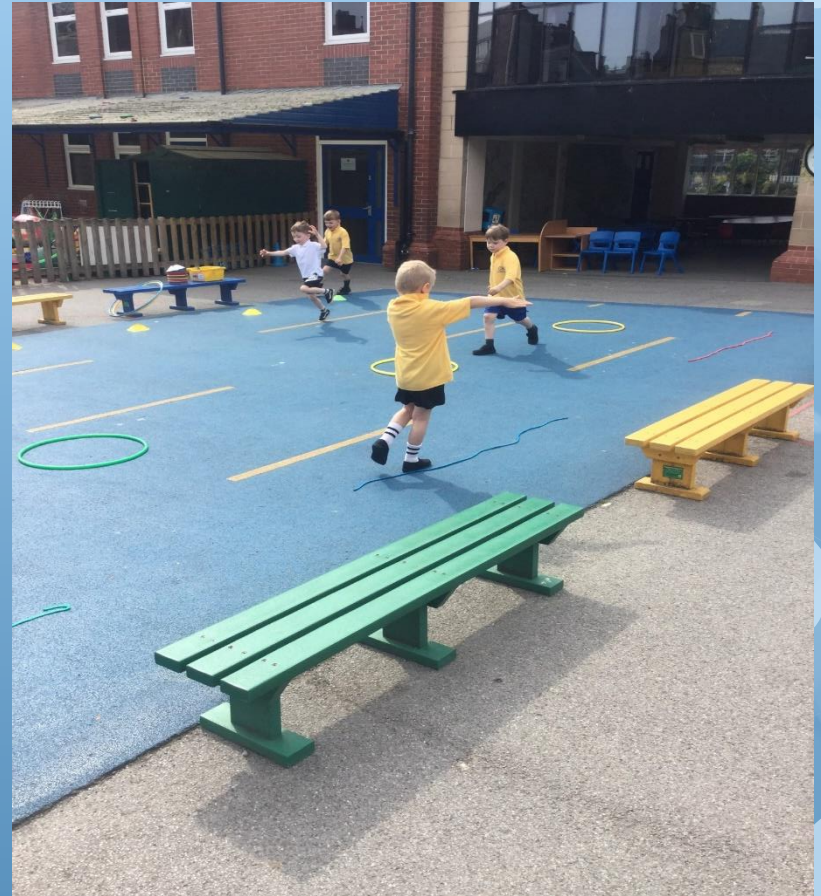






# Christmas plays, parties and birthdays.
