Literacy

This week we will be reading a story called Handa's Surprise. We will be listening to and describing African music and investigating different fruits and thinking of words to describe them.

We will also continue our phonics lessons. We will be learning some new sounds l, ll and ss and the actions that accompany these.

Mathematics

We will begin to learn about the number 4 and explore different ways that we can represent this, through writing, drawing and using classroom resources.

We will be printing with different fruits and counting how many there are. We will be learning some 3-D shape names and having a fruit shop where the children pay for different fruits.

In our creative area we will be painting and printing animal patterns. We will also be doing observational drawing of cross sections of different fruits and making animal masks.
