Mathematics

We will be continuing to learn about our number of the week – **1** – and explore different ways that we can represent this, through writing, drawing and using classroom resources.

In the outdoor area we will be playing number splat to help with number recognition and as an extension we will be counting out the right amount of bears to match the number we have splatted.

We will also be playing with the skittles to see how many we can knock down. This will help with our counting skills



Other Areas of Learning

In line with our story we will be looking at different sizes of animals.

In the construction area we will be making giraffes out of cubes to explore measuring height.

We will also be using our magnetic shapes to make different sized cages for different animals.

In our creative area we will be looking at patterns on animals and we will try to recreate these using paints, pencils and chalks.
