

Phonics Play



Phonics play is an interactive learning tool where children can practise and build-on their phonics skills.

In Gladstone Road School we have found that children are really engaged playing these games and it helps to promote many areas of their reading learning such as recognising sight words or becoming more fluent and fast in their reading.

To access the tools available go to www.phonicsplay.co.uk and enter the login details in the bottom green box:

Once the page is accessed, there are three different options which will give guidance on a **teacher level**, **parent level** and **child level**. It is recommended to read the parent level guidance before just for a heads up on the use of the website.

In EYFS children should be fairly secure on phase 2 and 3, and we are currently learning phase 4. Phonics requires a lot of recapping so any of these phases are our recommendations to explore!
