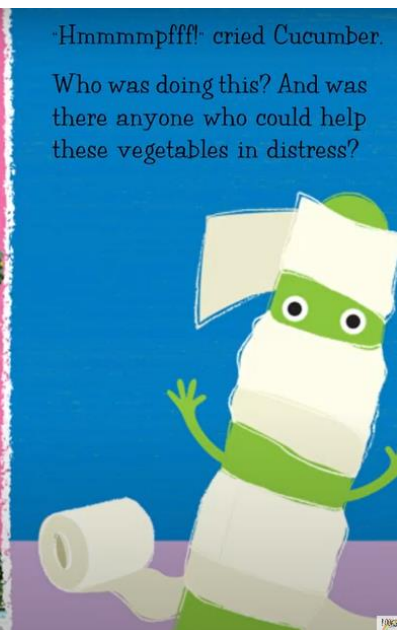
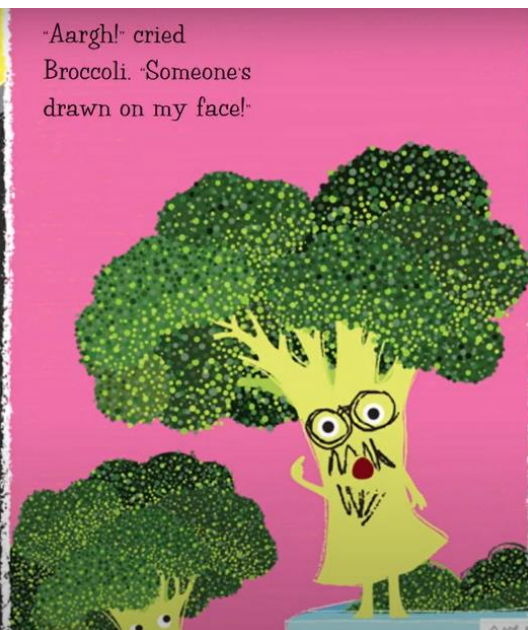

2	<p>Sound of the day 'v'</p> <p>Read: vat, vex, visit</p> <p>Segment and spell independently in journals: vet, van, velvet</p> <p>Create a picture for each word.</p>	<p>Read one of your phonics books.</p> <p>Task: Discuss what happens in the story with a grown-up. Can you explain the events?</p>	<p>Draw and label a picture of Supertato. Can you write some sentences:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • He has... • He is... <p>Use your phonics mats in the back of your journal to help with spelling.</p>	<p>WHITEROSE SUMMER WEEK 1 SESSION 2</p> <p>Additional task: Use your fridge to do a shape hunt! What shapes can you find? Draw the items in your journal and label with their maths names!</p>	<p>Can you sort the foods in your fridge into healthy and unhealthy groups? You could even design a 'healthy' and 'unhealthy' plate poster!</p>
3	<p>Sound of the day 'th/th' *Check Youtube for pronunciation!</p> <p>Read: this, thick, moth</p> <p>Segment and spell independently in journals: bath, path, that</p> <p>Create a picture for each word.</p>	<p>Read your tricky words together with a grown-up.</p> <p>Don't forget you can always sing the 'Tricky Words Songs' on YouTube!</p>	<p>Practise letter formation of the following curly caterpillar letters: q, e, s, f</p> <p>(formation support sheets in back of journal).</p>	<p>WHITEROSE SUMMER WEEK 1 SESSION 3</p> <p>Additional task: Make a timetable of your day! What would you do in the morning? How about the afternoon? What do you do on an evening? Extra challenge: Ask a grown-up to help you write the times on!</p>	<p>Design a home for Supertato and his friends. You could create something big, like a den, or smaller homes out of lego, card, tubes, sticks etc.</p> <p>Be creative!</p>
4	<p>Sound of the day 'w'</p> <p>Read: wet, will, went</p> <p>Segment and spell independently in journals: web, wing, wigwam</p> <p>Create a picture for each word.</p>	<p>Share a book of your choice with a grown-up.</p> <p>Task: Can you act out one of the scenes? Don't forget to include your grown-ups!</p>	<p>Create a wanted poster for Evil Pea! Don't forget to include a description and what crimes he has committed. Can you include some tricky words such as he, the, into, they, was, so.</p>	<p>WHITEROSE WEEK 2 SESSION 4</p> <p>Additional task: Create a repeating pattern using different toys i.e. red lego, yellow lego, red lego... Draw, label and explain these in your journal!</p>	<p>Create your own Superhero mask. Think about what materials will be flexible. You could also use card and lolly sticks to create a hand-held mask. Be creative!</p>

5	<p>Sound of the day 'ai'</p> <p>Read: wait, main, bait</p> <p>Segment and spell independently in journals: pain, sail, tail</p> <p>Create a picture for each word.</p>	<p>Read one of your phonics books.</p> <p>Task: Read it again and keep a tally of all the tricky words you discover! I wonder if you can find at least 5?</p>	<p>Design your own super veggie or super fruit.</p> <p>Design a name for it and a superpower that it will have!</p> <p>Use your phonics mats in the back of your journal to help with spelling.</p>	<p>WHITEROSE WEEK 2</p> <p>SESSION 5</p> <p>Additional task: Practise your tallying skills up to 10! 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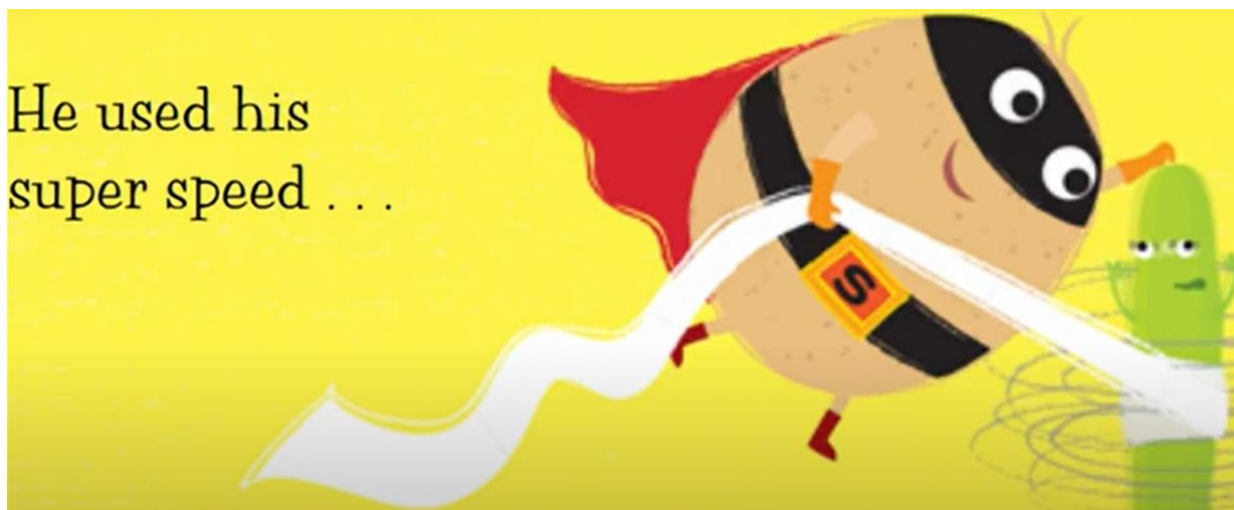

and some soapy water.



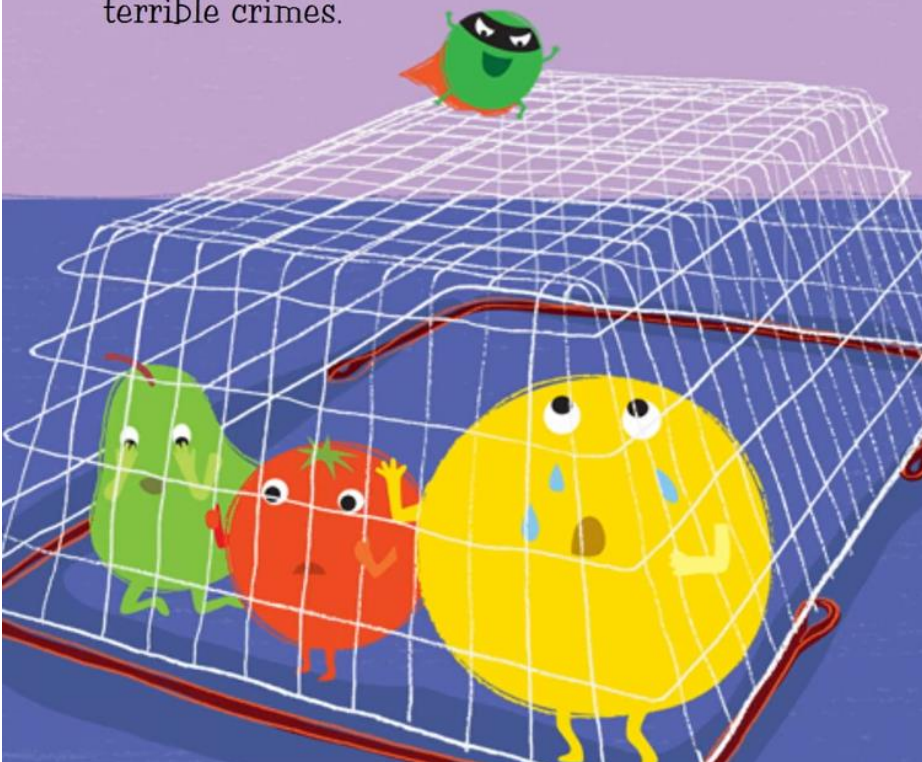
"I know who's behind this," said Supertato.

caught his eye.



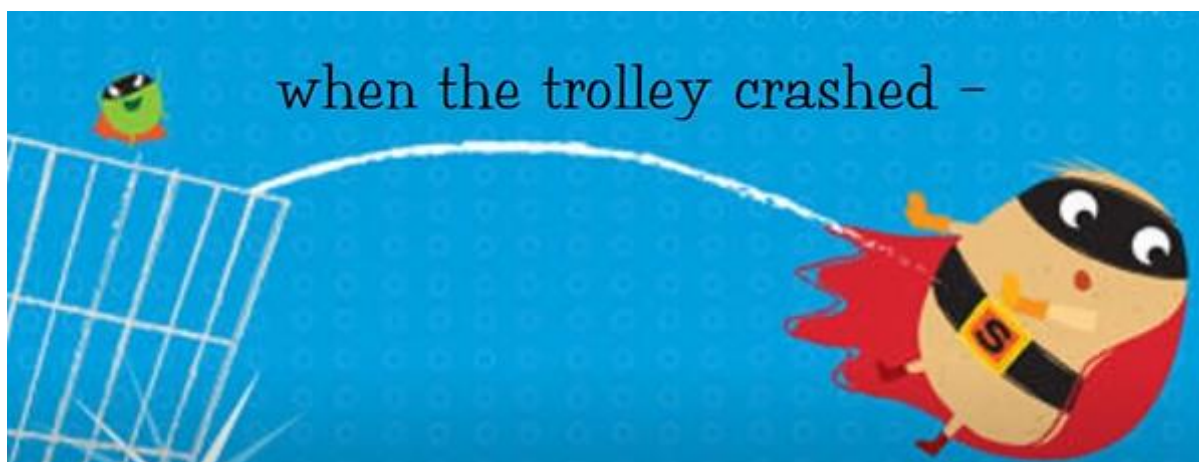
"The game's up!"

all his strength . . .



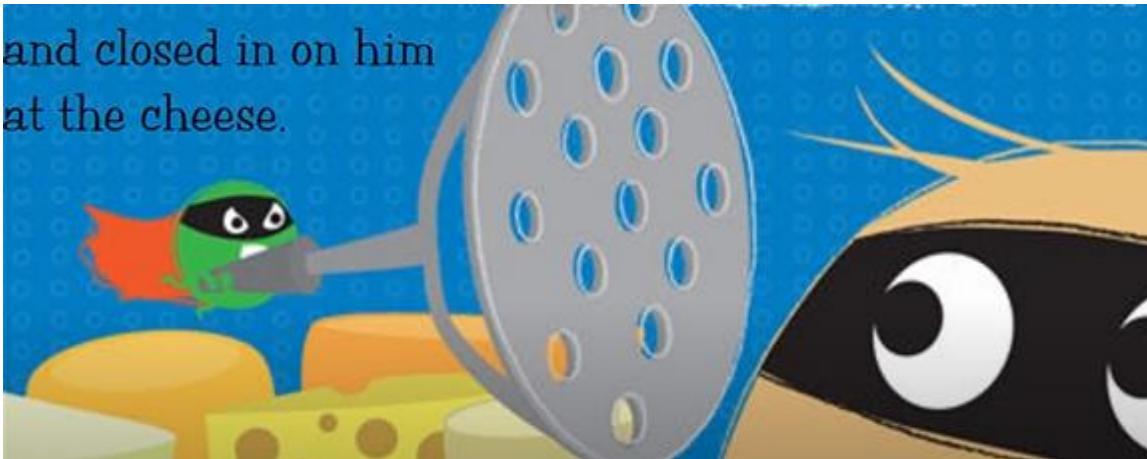
and ran for it.

grinned a super grin.

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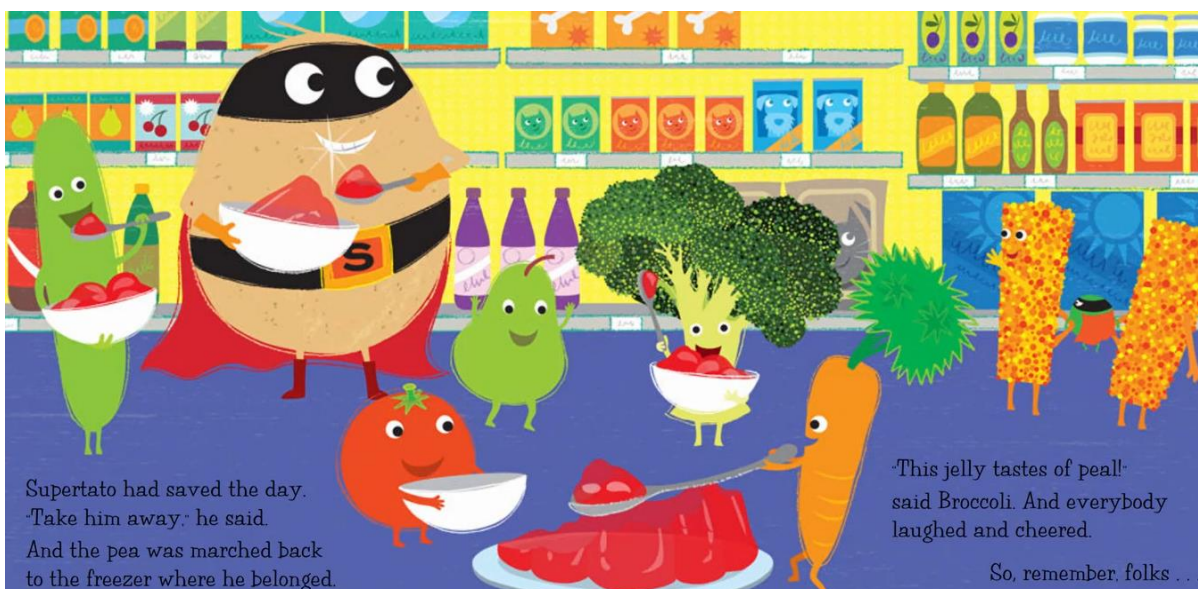
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Supertato had saved the day.
