
Sound of the day 'ear'

4+6, 2+8. Can you write then all in your journal?


	Challenge: Ask an adult to say a number from 0 to 10. Can you tell your adult what number you have to add to it for them to

	You could use playdough, paint, rocks, Lego, paper plates. Be creative!	




Phonics	Sound of the day 'air'








On Tuesday

On Thursday he ate through four strawberries, but he was still hungry.




On Friday he ate through five oranges, but he was still hungry.

one lollipop, one piece of cherry pie, one sausage, one cupcake, and one slice of watermelon.






Now he wasn't hungry any more—and he wasn't a little caterpillar any more.
