	Write a character description for the bee. Use capital letters and full stops in your writing.

	solved the problem?
Writing	Write a character description for a different creature that could have visited Cody in the garden.
	What is your creature? What does it look like? Is it big or small? Does it fly?
	Maybe you could tell me if it is a carnivore, herbivore or an omnivore.
	Write in full sentences using capital letters full stops and connecting words like 'and' to make your work even better.

























Cody smiled but didn't feel sure. "Maybe one day," she said.
