Reading	 Task: Read the same book you read yesterday. Did you like the book you read this week? What was your favourite part? Can you write a mini book review? A couple of sentences to explain your thoughts about the book: Did you like it? Why? What was the best bit? Maybe you disliked it, if so can you explain why?

	Task: Read or watch Messy Magpie. How can we help Morris? Make a poster to put up in Morris' home to tell people what to do with their rubbish.
