To provide more space while you are waiting, we have been opening the gates to the playgrounds in the hope that you will easily find a safe space. Please do what you feel comfortable with. No child will be left unsupervised while in our care, so do wait on the pavements or surrounding areas for a few minutes if you feel it is too busy. We have found the numbers of adults in any one area do fluctuate during the collection times. It is important that you do not feel anxious in anyway. It has really helped us by you not driving up Wooler Street in the morning or afternoon. The street has been much safer.

The staff and senior team have worked exceptionally hard to ensure our children had the best start. They have adapted to last minute changes in the systems with gusto and are absolute stars.
